

RULES OF THE GAME

HIGH CARD FLUSH™

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Each game, the player tries to obtain a hand with as many cards of the same suit as possible.

THE CARDS

High Card Flush™ is played with a 52-card deck. In decreasing order, the value of the cards is Ace, King, Queen, Jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2. Aces may be used for a straight flush (Ace-2 to Ace-2-3-4-5-6-7).

THE BETS

The maximum number of players at a High Card Flush™ table is six.

Using value chips purchased at the casino, each player may place an initial bet in accordance with the minimum and maximum limits indicated at the table. His bet must be placed in the designated spot before the first hand is dealt. Subject to the player's options, bets may not be placed, changed or withdrawn thereafter.

THE DEAL AND PLAYER OPTIONS

The dealer deals seven cards face down to each player in turn, and seven cards face down to himself.

Players may not show their cards or consult with each other.

After receiving his cards, the player may either raise in accordance with the betting table or fold. If the player folds, he loses his initial bet.

BETTING TABLE

Player's cards	Raise
4 or fewer cards of the same suit	Amount equal to the initial bet
5 cards of the same suit	1 or 2 times the amount of the initial bet
6 or 7 cards of the same suit	1, 2 or 3 times the amount of the initial bet

Once all players have acted on their hand and placed their cards face down on the layout, the dealer reveals his cards.

To qualify, the dealer's seven-card hand must contain at least three cards of the same suit. Note that, should the dealer's hand contain only three cards of the same suit, the highest ranking of those cards must be a 9 or higher.

If the dealer's hand qualifies, the dealer reveals, in turn, the cards of each player who raised, comparing the rank of each player's hand to his own.

A player may withdraw his bets before the dealer reveals that player's hand. In that event, the cards of that player are not revealed to the other players.

THE SUITS

The ranking of High Card Flush hands is determined by the number of cards of the same suit. The hand with the most cards of the same suit wins.

When the dealer's and the player's seven-card hands have the same number of cards of the same suit, the winning hand is the hand that contains the highest ranked card in the flush. However, if all the cards are equal in rank, the hands will be deemed identical.

PAYOUTS

When the dealer's hand qualifies:

- a) If the player's hand outranks the dealer's hand, the player wins and his initial bet and raise are paid even money.
- b) If the dealer's hand outranks the player's hand, the player loses his initial bet and raise.
- c) If the player's hand is identical to the dealer's hand, the player's initial bet and raise are a push.

When the dealer's hand does not qualify:

- a) The player's initial bet wins and is paid even money.
- b) The player's raise is a push.

FLUSH BONUS SIDE BET

If indicated at the table, the player may place a Flush Bonus side bet in addition to his initial bet. The Flush Bonus side bet must be within the minimum and maximum limits indicated at the table and be placed in the designated spot before the first hand is dealt. A Flush Bonus side bet wins if the player's hand contains four or more cards of the same suit regardless of the dealer's hand, and even if the player has folded. A winning Flush Bonus side bet is paid in accordance with the payout table below.

FLUSH BONUS SIDE BET PAYOUT TABLE

7 CARDS OF THE SAME SUIT	300 to 1
6 CARDS OF THE SAME SUIT	100 to 1
5 CARDS OF THE SAME SUIT	10 to 1
4 CARDS OF THE SAME SUIT	1 to 1

Note that only the highest payout ratio is paid on a winning bet.

STRAIGHT FLUSH BONUS SIDE BET

If indicated at the table, the player may place a Straight Flush Bonus side bet in addition to his initial bet. The Straight Flush Bonus side bet must be within the minimum and maximum limits indicated at the table and be placed in the designated spot before the first hand is dealt. A Straight Flush Bonus side bet wins if the player's hand contains a straight with three or more cards of the same suit regardless of the dealer's hand, and even if the player has folded. A winning Straight Flush Bonus side bet is paid in accordance with the payout table below.

STRAIGHT FLUSH BONUS SIDE BET PAYOUT TABLE

7 CARD STRAIGHT OF THE SAME SUIT	8,000 to 1
6 CARD STRAIGHT OF THE SAME SUIT	1,000 to 1
5 CARD STRAIGHT OF THE SAME SUIT	100 to 1
4 CARD STRAIGHT OF THE SAME SUIT	60 to 1
3 CARD STRAIGHT OF THE SAME SUIT	7 to 1

Note that only the highest payout ratio is paid on a winning bet.
