

GOING TO WAR

When your card is of equal rank to the dealer's card, you may choose to:

- **SURRENDER.** By surrendering, you remove yourself from the current round of play and forfeit half of your initial bet.
- **GO TO WAR.** If you choose this option, you must place an additional bet equal to your initial bet. The dealer will deal another card to you and to himself.
- If the value of that card ranks higher than the dealer's card, you win the war. Your initial bet is then paid 1 to 1 and your additional bet neither wins nor loses and you may take it back.
- If the value of that card is equal in rank to the dealer's card, you win the war. Your initial bet and your additional bet are paid 1 to 1.
- If that card ranks lower than the dealer's card, you lose the war. You lose your initial bet and your additional bet.



TIE SIDE BET

If indicated at the table, you may place a Tie Bet (side bet) in addition to your initial bet.

This bet must respect the minimum and maximum limits indicated at the table and be placed in the designated spot on the table before the first card is distributed.

The Tie Bet is a winner if the first card you are dealt is equal in rank to the dealer's first card. The payout on a Tie Bet is 10 to 1.

These rules come into force on August 23rd, 2012, and are governed by the *By-law respecting casino games* (R.S.Q. c. S-13.1, s. 13). The Société des casinos du Québec inc. may amend the rules herein at any time and without notice. 10-541.36-201209

CASINO WAR

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Casino War is an easy game and a lot of fun.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

During each game, the player attempts to obtain a card that ranks higher than the dealer's card.



THE CARDS

Casino War is played with 6 to 8 decks of 52 cards. Card ranking, in decreasing order, is Ace, King, Queen, Jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2.

THE BETS

The maximum number of players at a Casino War table is the number of betting positions at the table.

Place your initial bet using chips purchased from the dealer. Bets must be within minimum and maximum limits indicated at the table and be placed in the designated spot before the first card is dealt. Thereafter, an initial bet may not be placed, changed or withdrawn.

THE DEAL

From the shoe, the dealer deals one card face up to each player and one card face up to himself. Only the dealer may touch the cards.

PAYOUTS

Once the cards are dealt, the dealer compares his card to that of each player:

- If your card ranks higher than the dealer's card, your initial bet wins and is paid out 1 to 1.
- If your card ranks lower than the dealer's card, you lose your initial bet.
